Supplies clearly **LABELED** with your child's name:

Please **do not** label with subject or use we will do this in class

- 1 backpack- this will be used for bringing their binder to and from school daily and to practice organizational skills. NO rolling backpacks.
- Clipboard (small clip)
- Lunch Box
- Art Smock or Big t-shirt (please make sure it covers your child's shirt completely/no button-ups)
- 2 - One inch three ring all white binder (clear view pocket in front and pockets inside)
  - USE: Homework Binder and a Religion Binder
- 5 - Composition books (no plastic covers)
  - USE: Math, Free Draw and Write, Social Studies, Homework Notebook (2)
- 3 - Two Pocket fastener (three prong) PAPER folder (Blue, Red, Yellow)
  - USE: Progressfolio, Writer's Workshop, Calendar
- 1 - College rule spiral notebook
  - USE: Word Work Notebook

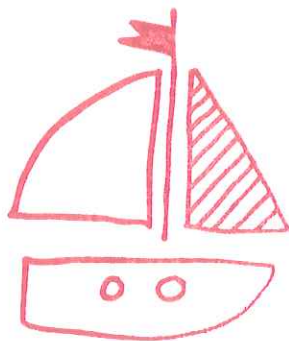
## Community Supplies (do NOT label with name):

- 1 box of sandwich bags
- 1 container of clorox wipes

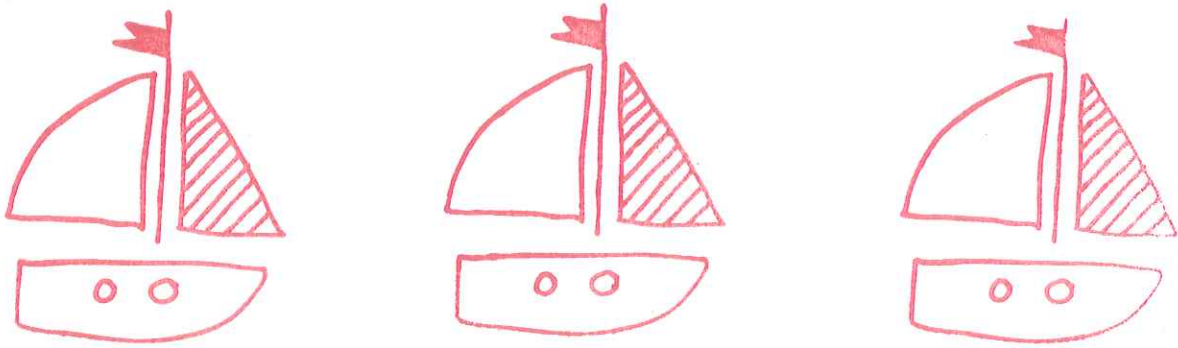

## Summer Choice Menu

- Rainbow Names: Write your name five times using different colors
- ABC's with Clay: Using clay have your child practice forming and saying each letter. You can mold the letter then your child can identify it, and practice sound.
- Letter sounds- After identifying the letter name, work on the sound it makes. What words make that sound?
- Letter Hunt- hide some letters (made from paper, or scrabble pieces) and go on a letter hunt. Once you find a letter say its name and sound
- Counting fun- with a friend, start counting from one and alternate each person. Count as high as you can
- Magic finger- write the number in the air with your magic finger
- What makes that number?- Have student collect a certain number of objects (for example: three beans, 5 blocks, etc.)
